Once a week, one student will be the “news manager” (see the schedule)

The news manager will present some news (2 or 3 events) by answering the following questions: WHO? WHAT? WHEN? WHERE? WHY? WHAT FOR? It will be a 3-minute presentation, focusing on news about the English-speaking world.

The news manager will have notes (only keywords), but no written sentences. He/she will also prepare a powerpoint/prezi/... presentation.

At the end of the presentation, the news manager will give 3 key words that will be written down in the copybooks (beware of vocabulary tests 😊)
